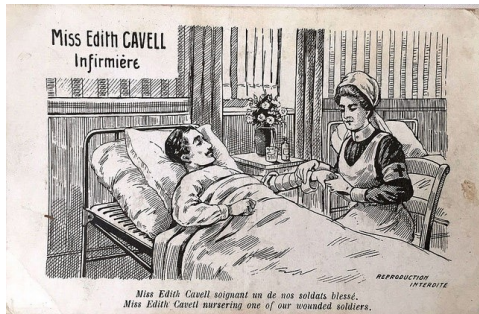

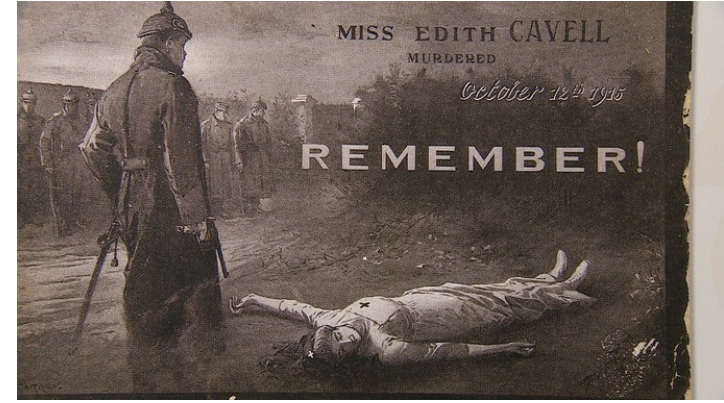


Edith Cavell loved Norwich Cathedral. She visited many times when she was growing up.
