SAFEGUARDING AUDIT: Social Care Institute for Excellence – Keeping People Safe. From Tuesday 1 to Thursday 3 October 2019, Norwich Cathedral will participate in an independent audit, commissioned by the Church of England, to look at Cathedral arrangements for keeping people safe from harm and abuse.
