The Psalms follow the pattern in the Book of Common Prayer with Morning and Evening Psalms alternating monthly.*

**PRINCIPAL FEASTS** and other **PRINCIPAL HOLY DAYS** (Christmas Day, Ash Wednesday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday etc.) are printed in bold capitals in the Lectionary.

Where **FESTIVALS** are moved to the nearest Sunday, the 8am Holy Communion should be the Eucharist of the Day.

**FESTIVALS** are printed in small bold capitals.

**Lesser Festivals** are printed in small bold print.

*Commemorations* are marked in italic and not in bold print.

For Principal Feasts, Principal Holy Days, Festivals and Lesser Festivals, there is full liturgical provision with Readings and Propers for the day and the colour of the day is marked.

Commemorations use the Readings, Collect of the day and the colour of the season.
