

The use of drones

at Norwich Cathedral



The use of of small unmanned aircraft (drones) in or around the Cathedral or Close is strictly prohibited without our prior written consent, Civil Aviation Certification and proof of £10m indemnity insurance.

The reasons for this are safety, security, privacy of our visitors and residents, and the risk of costly damage to the historic fabric.

In addition to this, since there are nesting peregrine falcons on the Cathedral Spire, it is a criminal offence to disturb these protected birds.
